 - TOEFL: 61+ (With min. sub-scores of 15 for both the Reading and the Listening sections)
 - IELTS: 6+ (With min. sub-scores of 5.5 in the Listening section and a 6 in the Reading section)
- GPA: Minimum 2.5 out of 4.0
- Financial documentation
- Complete high school transcripts (in English)

*Not required for conditional admission

- Proof of English proficiency*:
 - TOEFL: 80+
 - IELTS: 6.5+
- GPA: Minimum 3.0 out of 4.0
- Personal Statement
- Letters of recommendation
- Complete university transcripts (in English)
- External professional credential evaluation (WES or ECE preferred)
- Financial documentation
- CV, interview, or other documentation may be required
